Te Aka Whai Ora is responsible for partnering with, and funding service providers to be able to continue providing existing services or to begin providing new services.

The information you have requested is not held by Te Aka Whai Ora, and we have no grounds for believing that the information is either held by or connected more closely with the functions of another department or Minister or organisation. As such, Te Aka Whai Ora is refusing your request under sections 18(g)(i) and 18(g)(ii) of the OIA.
